**Application process and documents required:** Resume & letter of interest, in English, indicating specific goals you have for the internship, how you would prepare to work in Malaysia, and your engineering experience (electrical/computer/software). All documents should be in MS-Word or PDF format, please, and submitted electronically. Please do not send files over 500kb.

**Major internship duties and responsibilities:** This internship will focus on the development of custom electronic products and embedded systems. Opportunities exist in either hardware or software development. Students that have completed a solid base of engineering coursework will be best suited for this hands-on engineering opportunity.

Product development teams are comprised of engineers from our various functional groups. These design groups include Analog Hardware, Digital Hardware, Embedded Software, Mechanical, PCB Layout, In-Circuit Test, and Functional Test. Each project team is led by one of our project managers-- each with prior experience as a design engineer.
